- 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 6 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 7 INDICATED.
- 8 (B) "COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATION" MEANS A COMMUNITY-BASED
- 9 ORGANIZATION THAT PROVIDES SERVICES TO HELP DEVELOP MARRIAGE AND
- 10 RELATIONSHIP SKILLS.
- 11 (C) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES.

(A) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES FOR ADMINISTERING THE 10 PROGRAM, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL: (1) REVIEW PLANS SUBMITTED BY COMMUNITY-BASED 12 ORGANIZATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM AND DETERMINE WHICH 13 COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATIONS ARE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE FUNDING; 14 (2) REVIEW RENEWAL APPLICATIONS FROM PARTICIPATING 15 COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATIONS; AND DISTRIBUTE GRANTS TO ELIGIBLE COMMUNITY-BASED 16 17 ORGANIZATIONS. 18 151. 19 AN ENTITY THAT RECEIVES FUNDING UNDER THE PROGRAM CREATED UNDER 20 THIS SUBTITLE OR UNDER THE FEDERAL HEALTHY MARRIAGE INITIATIVE SHALL 21 ENSURE THAT DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COUNSELING SERVICES ARE PROVIDED TO 22 INDIVIDUALS IN THE ENTITY'S PROGRAM. 23 152. NOTHING IN THIS SUBTITLE PREVENTS A COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATION 25 FROM OBTAINING FUNDING FROM A PRIVATE SOURCE. 26 **Article - Family Law** 27 10-112. [If] SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, IF the 28 (a) (1) 29 Administration considers it to be in the best interest of this State, in a case in which 30 an assignment has been made under Article 88A, § 50(b)(2) of the Code, the 31 Administration may accept in full settlement of an arrearage in child support 32 payments an amount that is less than the total arrearage. 33 IF ARREARAGES ACCRUE AFTER AN ASSIGNMENT HAS BEEN MADE (2) 34 UNDER ARTICLE 88A, § 50(B)(2) OF THE CODE AND THE OBLIGOR AND OBLIGEE 35 SUBSEQUENTLY REUNITE, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT TAKE ANY ACTION TO

- 1 COLLECT THE SUPPORT ARREARAGES UNLESS THE REUNITED FAMILY HAS A GROSS
- 2 INCOME EQUAL TO OR GREATER THAN 225 PERCENT OF THE FEDERAL POVERTY
- 3 LEVEL, AS DEFINED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN
- 4 SERVICES.
- 5 (b) On request of the Administration, a court may approve by order an amount
- 6 that is less than the total arrearage as full settlement of the arrearage.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of
- 8 Human Resources shall report to the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee and the
- 9 House Appropriations Committee on or before July 1 of each year, in accordance with
- 10 § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on the marriage promotion programs
- 11 granted funding under this Act, including an evaluation of the effectiveness of the
- 12 programs in promoting marriage in the State.
- 13 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of
- 14 Human Resources, in consultation with the Department of Health and Mental
- 15 Hygiene, shall study the effectiveness of publicly-funded family planning programs,
- 16 teen pregnancy prevention programs, and community, school, and faith-based
- 17 abstinence education programs on preventing unwed pregnancy and unwed
- 18 childbearing. The Department shall report to the Senate Budget and Taxation
- 19 Committee and the House Appropriations Committee on or before October 1, 2005, in
- 20 accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on the findings of the
- 21 study.
- 22 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 23 effect July 1, 2004.
