- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article State Finance and Procurement
- 19 SUBTITLE 10. PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGEMENT.
- 20 3-1001.
- 21 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 22 INDICATED.
- 23 (B) "CARRIER" MEANS:
- 24 (1) AN INSURER;
- 25 (2) A NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN;
- 26 (3) A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION; OR

- 1 (4) A DENTAL PLAN ORGANIZATION.
- 2 (C) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND 3 MANAGEMENT.
- 4 (D) "PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGEMENT" MEANS THE PROCUREMENT OF
- 5 PRESCRIPTION DRUGS AT A NEGOTIATED RATE FOR DISPENSATION WITHIN THE
- 6 STATE.

- 8 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DETERMINE IF IT IS ADVANTAGEOUS TO USE A
- 9 PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGEMENT SERVICE THAT IS INDEPENDENT FROM A
- 10 CARRIER FOR A HEALTH OR PHARMACY BENEFIT PROGRAM PROVIDED BY THE
- 11 DEPARTMENT OR OTHER STATE AGENCY.
- 12 (B) IF THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THAT PHARMACY BENEFITS
- 13 MANAGEMENT SERVICES MAY BE ADVANTAGEOUS TO A HEALTH OR PHARMACY
- 14 BENEFITS PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OR OTHER STATE
- 15 AGENCY, THE DEPARTMENT OR STATE AGENCY SHALL SEEK BIDS FOR PHARMACY
- 16 BENEFITS MANAGEMENT SERVICES ON A CONTRACTUAL BASIS FROM A NONPROFIT
- 17 PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGEMENT ENTITY.
- 18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 19 October 1, 2004.
