17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19Article - Education

21 (A) A COMMUNITY COLLEGE DESIRING TO PARTICIPATE IN A 22 SITE-DETERMINED BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PROGRAM SHALL:

(1) IDENTIFY A BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PROGRAM THAT IS NOT
CURRENTLY OFFERED IN THE REGION OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE BUT IS
PROPOSED FOR DELIVERY AT THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR THE REGIONAL HIGHER
EDUCATION CENTER TO MEET THE ACADEMIC AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
NEEDS OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE;

1(2)SEEK INPUT FROM STUDENTS, WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT2COUNCILS, AND OTHER CIVIC, EDUCATIONAL, COMMUNITY, AND BUSINESS GROUPS3WHEN ASSESSING THE LOCAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS OF THE COMMUNITY;

4 (3) DETERMINE THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS INTERESTED IN PURSUING 5 EACH PROPOSED BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PROGRAM;

6 (4) IDENTIFY THE ENROLLMENT PATTERNS, SPECIAL
7 CHARACTERISTICS OF THE STUDENTS, AND OTHER UNIQUE CIRCUMSTANCES THAT
8 WOULD REQUIRE A PARTICULAR COMBINATION OF COURSES OR MODIFICATION OF
9 COURSE OFFERINGS TO MEET THE STUDENT ENROLLMENT NEEDS; AND

(5) SUBMIT A REQUEST FOR A SITE-DETERMINED BACCALAUREATE
 DEGREE PROGRAM PROPOSAL TO A "4-YEAR INSTITUTION" OF POSTSECONDARY
 EDUCATION IN THE STATE.

13 (B) THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE'S REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL SHALL INCLUDE:

14 (1) A DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPOSED BACCALAUREATE DEGREE 15 PROGRAM THAT IDENTIFIES THE UPPER LEVEL COURSES TO BE OFFERED;

16 (2) A STATEMENT EXPLAINING WHETHER THE PROPOSED
17 BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PROGRAM IS BEING OFFERED FOR A LIMITED PERIOD OR
18 AS AN ONGOING PROGRAM;

19(3)AN ESTIMATE OF THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS TO BE SERVED BY THE20PROPOSED BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PROGRAM; AND

(4) A STATEMENT ASSURING THAT THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE'S
 EXISTING FACILITIES ARE SUFFICIENT TO MEET THE ADDITIONAL DEMANDS FOR
 THE PROPOSED BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PROGRAM.

(C) A COMMUNITY COLLEGE MAY SUBMIT THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL TO
OFFER A BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PROGRAM TO AN OUT-OF-STATE 4-YEAR
INSTITUTION OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION IF NONE OF THE IN-STATE 4-YEAR
INSTITUTIONS OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION RESPOND TO THE COMMUNITY
COLLEGE'S REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL TO OFFER A BACCALAUREATE DEGREE
PROGRAM.

30 (D) PRIOR TO SUBMITTING A REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL TO AN OUT-OF-STATE 31 4-YEAR INSTITUTION OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION, THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE 32 SHALL:

33 (1) VALIDATE THE ACCREDITATION AND THE PROPOSED
34 BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PROGRAM OF THE OUT-OF-STATE 4-YEAR INSTITUTION
35 OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION;

(2) ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OUT-OF-STATE 4-YEAR
 POSTSECONDARY INSTITUTION SELECTED TO PROVIDE THE UPPER LEVEL COURSES
 IN THE PROPOSED BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PROGRAM; AND

1 (3) SUBMIT APPROPRIATE INFORMATION TO THE MARYLAND HIGHER 2 EDUCATION COMMISSION TO MONITOR THE ANNUAL PERFORMANCE OF THE 3 PROGRAM.

4 (E) THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION SHALL MONITOR THE 5 ANNUAL PERFORMANCE OF THE PROGRAM.

6 (F) AN OUT-OF-STATE 4-YEAR INSTITUTION OF POSTSECONDARY
7 EDUCATION THAT ENTERS INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH A COMMUNITY COLLEGE IN
8 THIS SECTION MAY OPERATE IN THE STATE WITHOUT A CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL
9 FROM THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION UNDER § 11-202 OF THIS
10 ARTICLE.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 2004.

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
