3 FO	PR the purpose of requiring a public institution of higher education to allow a	
4	certain national guard student to withdraw from courses the national guard	
5	student is currently enrolled in without negative consequences to the national	
6	guard student's academic standing if the national guard student's unit is	
7	activated and deployed to a location outside the State; requiring a public	
8	institution of higher education to try to assist the national guard student in

- 9 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "NATIONAL GUARD STUDENT" MEANS A STUDENT WHO
- 10 IS ENROLLED IN A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND IS A MEMBER
- 11 OF THE UNITED STATES NATIONAL GUARD.
- 12 (B) A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL ALLOW A
- 13 NATIONAL GUARD STUDENT TO WITHDRAW FROM COURSES THE NATIONAL GUARD
- 14 STUDENT IS CURRENTLY ENROLLED IN WITHOUT NEGATIVE CONSEQUENCES TO
- 15 THE NATIONAL GUARD STUDENT'S ACADEMIC STANDING IF THE NATIONAL GUARD
- 16 STUDENT'S UNIT IS ACTIVATED AND DEPLOYED TO A LOCATION OUTSIDE THE STATE.
- 17 (C) A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL TRY TO ASSIST THE
- 18 NATIONAL GUARD STUDENT IN COMPLETING THE COURSE REQUIREMENTS BY

- 20 (1) GIVING THE NATIONAL GUARD STUDENT A GRADE OF INCOMPLETE

- 25 (I) THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND UNIVERSITY COLLEGE'S
- 26 DISTANCE EDUCATION COURSES; OR
- 27 (II) THE SOUTHERN REGIONAL EDUCATION BOARD'S ELECTRONIC
- 28 CAMPUS.
- 29 (D) A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION MAY PROVIDE FOR A FULL
- 30 OR PARTIAL TUITION REFUND TO A NATIONAL GUARD STUDENT WHO HAS
- 31 WITHDRAWN FROM COURSES DUE TO THE ACTIVATION AND DEPLOYMENT OF THE
- 32 NATIONAL GUARD STUDENT'S UNIT.
