8 institution of higher education to try to assist the national guard student in

11 a national guard student who has withdrawn from courses due to the activation

12 and deployment of the national guard student's unit; defining a certain term;

13 and generally relating to requiring a public institution of higher education to

15 student is deployed outside the State.

21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "NATIONAL GUARD STUDENT" MEANS A STUDENT WHO
IS ENROLLED IN A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND IS A MEMBER
OF THE UNITED STATES NATIONAL GUARD.

28 (B) A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL ALLOW A

4 (C) A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL TRY TO ASSIST THE 5 NATIONAL GUARD STUDENT IN COMPLETING THE COURSE REQUIREMENTS BY 6 EITHER:

7 (1) GIVING THE NATIONAL GUARD STUDENT A GRADE OF INCOMPLETE
8 AND WORKING WITH THE NATIONAL GUARD STUDENT AND THE STUDENT'S
9 INSTRUCTOR ON A PROGRAM OF INDEPENDENT STUDY; OR

10(2)TRANSFERRING THE NATIONAL GUARD STUDENT TO AN ONLINE11COURSE OF INSTRUCTION OFFERED AT AN INSTITUTION SUCH AS:

12 (I) THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND UNIVERSITY COLLEGE'S 13 DISTANCE EDUCATION COURSES; OR

14(II)THE SOUTHERN REGIONAL EDUCATION BOARD'S ELECTRONIC15CAMPUS.

16 (D) A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION MAY PROVIDE FOR A FULL
17 OR PARTIAL TUITION REFUND TO A NATIONAL GUARD STUDENT WHO HAS
18 WITHDRAWN FROM COURSES DUE TO THE ACTIVATION AND DEPLOYMENT OF THE
19 NATIONAL GUARD STUDENT'S UNIT.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 2004.
