FOR the purpose of requiring a public institution of higher education to allow a certain national guard student to withdraw from courses the national guard student is currently enrolled in without negative consequences to the national guard student's academic standing if the national guard student's unit is activated and deployed to a location outside the State; requiring a public institution of higher education to try to assist the national guard student in completing the course requirements under certain circumstances; authorizing a public institution of higher education to provide a full or partial tuition refund to a national guard student who has withdrawn from courses due to the activation and deployment of the national guard student's unit; defining a certain term; and generally relating to requiring a public institution of higher education to allow a national guard student to withdraw from courses if the national guard student is deployed outside the State.
