- 21 (a) To provide a fund to pay the expense of protecting and managing wildlife,
- 22 and preventing unauthorized persons from hunting them, a person may not hunt or
- 23 attempt to hunt during open season and in any permitted manner any game birds and
- 24 mammals in the State without first having procured either a resident or nonresident
- 25 hunter's license. A person may not hunt or attempt to hunt nongame birds and
- 26 mammals in Baltimore County or Frederick County without first obtaining a license.
- 27 A permanent resident of a government reservation may obtain a resident hunter's
- 28 license.
