25	(2) (i)	"Noneconomic damages" means:

1 1. In an action for personal injury, pain, suffering, 2 inconvenience, physical impairment, disfigurement, loss of consortium, or other 3 nonpecuniary injury; and

2. In an action for wrongful death, mental anguish, 5 emotional pain and suffering, loss of society, companionship, comfort, protection, care, 6 marital care, parental care, filial care, attention, advice, counsel, training, guidance, 7 or education, or other noneconomic damages authorized under Title 3, Subtitle 9 of 8 this article.

(ii) "Noneconomic damages" does not include punitive damages.

10 (3) "Primary claimant" means a claimant in an action for the death of a 11 person described under § 3-904(d) of this article.

12 (4) "Secondary claimant" means a claimant in an action for the death of 13 a person described under § 3-904(b) of this article.

14 (b) (1) In any action for damages for personal injury in which the cause of 15 action arises on or after July 1, 1986, an award for noneconomic damages may not 16 exceed \$350,000.

17 (2) (i) Except as provided in paragraph (3)(ii) of this subsection, in any
18 action for damages for personal injury or wrongful death in which the cause of action
19 arises on or after October 1, 1994, an award for noneconomic damages may not exceed
20 \$500,000.

(ii) The limitation on noneconomic damages provided under
subparagraph (i) of this paragraph shall increase by \$15,000 on October 1 of each year
beginning on October 1, 1995. The increased amount shall apply to causes of action
arising between October 1 of that year and September 30 of the following year,
inclusive.

26 (3) (i) The limitation established under paragraph (2) of this 27 subsection shall apply in a personal injury action to each direct victim of tortious 28 conduct and all persons who claim injury by or through that victim.

(ii) In a wrongful death action in which there are two or more
claimants or beneficiaries, an award for noneconomic damages may not exceed 150%
of the limitation established under paragraph (2) of this subsection, regardless of the
number of claimants or beneficiaries who share in the award.

(4) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION, A CAUSE OF ACTION FOR
DAMAGES FOR PERSONAL INJURY IN A LATENT DISEASE OR LATENT INJURY CASE
ARISES ON THE EARLIER OF THE DIAGNOSIS OR THE MANIFESTATION OF SYMPTOMS
OF A LEGALLY COMPENSABLE INJURY OR DISEASE.

37 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be applied 38 to all cases filed or pending before a tribunal of competent jurisdiction in which a trial 39 has not commenced on or after July 1, 2004.
