A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Mental Hygiene Administration - State Facilities - Cemeteries

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the State from selling a cemetery owned by the State
- 4 and on the grounds of a State facility if the State facility is downsized,
- 5 consolidated, or sold; requiring the State to maintain and to mark with a certain
- 6 monument a cemetery owned by the State; prohibiting the transfer or sale of
- 7 certain easements or rights of entry; and generally relating to State-owned
- 8 cemeteries located on the grounds of State facilities.
- 9 BY adding to
- 10 Article Health General
- 11 Section 10-209
- 12 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 13 (2000 Replacement Volume and 2003 Supplement)
- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Health General
- 17 10-209.
- 18 (A) A CEMETERY OWNED BY THE STATE AND LOCATED ON THE GROUNDS OF A
- 19 STATE FACILITY MAY NOT BE SOLD BY THE STATE IF THE STATE FACILITY IS
- 20 DOWNSIZED, CONSOLIDATED, OR SOLD.
- 21 (B) A CEMETERY OWNED BY THE STATE SHALL BE MAINTAINED BY THE
- 22 STATE AND MARKED WITH A MONUMENT COMMEMORATING THE INDIVIDUALS
- 23 INTERRED IN THE CEMETERY.
- 24 (C) ANY EASEMENT OR RIGHT OF ENTRY TO A CEMETERY OWNED BY THE
- 25 STATE AND LOCATED ON THE GROUNDS OF A STATE FACILITY THAT HAS BEEN
- 26 RECORDED AMONG THE LAND RECORDS OF THE COUNTY WHERE THE CEMETERY IS
- 27 LOCATED ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2004 MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED OR SOLD.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 July 1, 2004.
