- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 (d) Each facility shall:
- 16 (1) On or before admission of an individual, give the individual a written
- 17 statement of:
- 18 (i) The services of the facility, including each service that is
- 19 required to be offered on an as-needed basis; [and]
- 20 (ii) Related charges, including any charges for services that are not
- 21 covered by Medicare, Medicaid, or the basic rate of the facility; and
- 22 (III) WHETHER THE FACILITY AND ATTENDING PHYSICIAN ACCEPT
- 23 THE INDIVIDUAL'S HEALTH INSURANCE; AND
