A BILL ENTITLED

1	AN ACT concerning
2	Public Safety - Correctional Services - Juvenile Inmates
3 4	FOR the purpose of requiring the Division of Correction to operate a separate unit for inmates committed to the Division who are under the age of 18 years; requiring
5	that the unit only house juveniles; providing that the Commissioner of
6	Correction has the same powers and duties relating to a juvenile inmate unit as
7	the Commissioner has for any other correctional facility in the Division;
8	requiring the Commissioner to provide juvenile inmates with educational
9	services; requiring the Commissioner to classify each juvenile inmate and
10	provide certain available treatment, training, or employment that the
11	Commissioner considers appropriate; and generally relating to juvenile inmates
12	committed to the Division of Correction.

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 21 **Article - Correctional Services**
- 22 SUBTITLE 3A. UNIT FOR JUVENILE INMATES.
- 23 3-3A-01.
- 24 IN THIS SECTION, "JUVENILE INMATE" MEANS AN INMATE COMMITTED TO
- 25 THE DIVISION OF CORRECTION WHO IS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS.

- 1 (B) (1) THE DIVISION OF CORRECTION SHALL OPERATE A SEPARATE UNIT 2 FOR JUVENILE INMATES.
- 3 (2) THE UNIT SHALL HOUSE ONLY JUVENILE INMATES.
- 4 (C) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, THE
- 5 COMMISSIONER HAS THE SAME POWERS AND DUTIES RELATING TO A UNIT FOR
- 6 JUVENILE INMATES AS THE COMMISSIONER HAS FOR ANY OTHER CORRECTIONAL
- 7 FACILITY IN THE DIVISION.
- 8 (D) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL:
- 9 (1) PROVIDE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES FOR JUVENILE INMATES; AND
- 10 (2) CLASSIFY EACH JUVENILE INMATE AND ASSIGN THE JUVENILE
- 11 INMATE TO THE AVAILABLE TREATMENT, TRAINING, OR EMPLOYMENT THAT THE
- 12 DIVISION CONSIDERS APPROPRIATE.
- 13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 14 effect October 1, 2004.
