## 1 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages** 2 15-207. 3 (h) (1) This subsection applies only in Worcester County. All net profits arising from the operation of these dispensaries 4 (2) 5 are first applied towards the payment of any and all sums advanced to or borrowed by 6 the Liquor Control Board THAT ARE CURRENTLY DUE AND OWING. 7 After these sums are paid, the Board is authorized to create and (II)8 maintain a reserve fund not to exceed \$400,000. 9 The reserve fund is maintained to provide adequate working (III)10 capital and to meet any losses that may be sustained by the Board in the operation of 11 these dispensaries. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency 12 13 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, 14 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members 15 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
