- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the University System of Maryland to undertake an

- of State government; requiring the analysis to include certain estimates;

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 22 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 23 INDICATED.
- 24 (2) "ECONOMIC AND FISCAL IMPACT ANALYSIS" MEANS AN ESTIMATE OF
- 25 THE COST OR THE ECONOMIC BENEFIT TO THE STATE AND ITS RESIDENTS OF THE
- 26 ACTIVITIES AND OPERATIONS OF A PROGRAM SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION.
- 27 "UNIVERSITY" OR "UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND" MEANS THE
- 28 UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF MARYLAND.

- 1 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO: 2 THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE SIDEWALK (1) 3 PROGRAM WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT; THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT (2) 5 FOR: THE NEIGHBORHOOD BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM; (I) 6 7 (II)THE COMMUNITY LEGACY PROGRAM; AND 8 (III)THE RENTAL HOUSING OFFICE SPACE CONVERSION PROGRAM: THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE COMMUNITY 10 PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS PROGRAM: THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT FOR THE BROWNFIELDS (4) 12 PROGRAM; AND THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT 13 14 FOR THE SUNNY DAY FUND. THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SHALL PREPARE AN ECONOMIC AND 16 FISCAL IMPACT ANALYSIS OF THE PROGRAMS DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) 17 OF THIS SECTION. 18 THE ECONOMIC AND FISCAL IMPACT ANALYSIS SHALL INCLUDE AN 19 ESTIMATE OF THE EFFECT OF THE PROGRAMS DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) 20 OF THIS SECTION ON: 21 SPENDING BY STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND BY PRIVATE (1) 22 ENTITIES: 23 (2) EMPLOYMENT: 24 (3) CONSUMER INCOME; AND
- ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2005, THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SHALL 26
- 27 SUBMIT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THIS ARTICLE, A REPORT OF THE

STATE AND LOCAL TAX REVENUES.

- 28 RESULTS OF THE ECONOMIC AND FISCAL IMPACT ANALYSIS REQUIRED UNDER THIS
- 29 SECTION TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.
- 30 THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE FUNDS IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2006 (F)
- 31 BUDGET IN AN AMOUNT SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE COSTS INCURRED BY THE
- 32 UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND FOR THE ECONOMIC AND FISCAL IMPACT ANALYSIS
- 33 REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION.

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1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 2 effect July 1, 2004.
