BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: The Charter of Baltimore City 15 16 Article II - General Powers The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore shall have full power and authority to 17

18 exercise all of the powers heretofore or hereafter granted to it by the Constitution of 19 Maryland or by any Public General or Public Local laws of the State of Maryland; and 20 in particular, without limitation upon the foregoing, shall have power by ordinance, or

- 2 said Constitution and Public General Laws:

- 4 (a) To regulate the construction and installation of public streets, lanes and
- 5 alleys, and private streets, lanes and alleys used or intended to be used by the public;
- 6 (b) To ascertain, fix, establish and mark on the ground, from time to time, the
- 7 lines and grades of any or all such public or private streets, lanes and alleys, or any
- 8 part or parts thereof, and to require conformity thereto;
- 9 (c) To regulate the construction and installation of utilities and other facilities
- 10 in, under or over any or all such public or private streets, lanes and alleys;
- 11 (d) To prevent encroachment on, or obstruction of, any of such public or
- 12 private streets, lanes or alleys, or any public places;
- 13 (E) TO <u>CLOSE OR</u> GATE OR CLOSE A PUBLIC <u>AN</u> ALLEY THAT IS NO LONGER
- 14 NEEDED FOR THROUGH PEDESTRIAN OR VEHICULAR TRAFFIC, IN ORDER TO
- 15 PROMOTE THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, OR WELFARE; AND
- 16 (F) TO LEASE A CLOSED OR GATED ALLEY TO AN ENTITY THAT IS FORMED BY
- 17 <u>CONSISTS OF THE PROPERTY</u> OWNERS OF A MAJORITY OF THE WHOSE LOTS
- 18 ABUTTING ABUT THE ALLEY.
