A MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL WHO IS A USER OF CHILD CARE 21 (2)22 SERVICES, A FAMILY DAY CARE PROVIDER, OR A CHILD CARE PROVIDER FROM A 23 CHILD CARE CENTER IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE 24 STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 25 26 effect October 1, 2004.

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
