## 1 Article - Business Regulation

- 3 (H) WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE FIRST MEETING OF THE COMMISSION AFTER
- 4 AN EXAMINATION DATE, THE COMMISSION SHALL NOTIFY AN APPLICANT IN
- 5 WRITING OF THE EXAMINATION SCORE OF THE APPLICANT.

- 7 (a) Within 30 days after the first meeting of the Commission after [an
- 8 examination date] SUBMISSION OF A COMPLETED APPLICATION, the Commission
- 9 shall notify an applicant in writing:

- 11 (2)] whether the application for a license is approved or denied; and
- 12 [(3)] (2) of the reasons for denial, if the application is denied.
- 13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 14 effect October 1, 2004.
