4 FOR the purpose of altering the procedures concerning notice of approval or denial of
5 a Home Improvement Commission license application; and generally relating to
6 the Maryland Home Improvement Commission.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Business Regulation2 8-302.

3 (H) WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE FIRST MEETING OF THE COMMISSION AFTER
4 AN EXAMINATION DATE, THE COMMISSION SHALL NOTIFY AN APPLICANT IN
5 WRITING OF THE EXAMINATION SCORE OF THE APPLICANT.

6 8-305.

7 (a) Within 30 days after the first meeting of the Commission after [an
8 examination date] SUBMISSION OF A COMPLETED APPLICATION, the Commission
9 shall notify an applicant in writing:

10 (1) [of the examination score of the applicant;

11 (2)] whether the application for a license is approved or denied; and

12 [(3)] (2) of the reasons for denial, if the application is denied.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
14 effect October 1, 2004.
