- 15 (a) The Secretary of State shall adopt regulations to establish fees, not to
- 16 exceed [\$2] \$5 for an original notarial act, and an appropriate lesser amount NOT TO
- 17 EXCEED \$3 for the repetition of that original notarial act or to make a copy of the
- 18 matter addressed by that original notarial act.

- 1 (b) A notary public may charge [19] 34 cents per mile, or a higher amount set 2 by regulation of the Secretary of State, and a fee not to exceed [\$5] \$10, as 3 compensation for travel required for the performance of a notarial act.
