- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 (A) THERE IS A STATE BOARD OF VETERINARY MEDICAL EXAMINERS FUND.
- 22 [(a)] (B) (1) The Board shall set reasonable fees necessary to carry out its
- 23 responsibilities under this subtitle.
- 24 [(b) Every examination and annual registration fee received by the Board shall
- 25 be paid into the General Fund of the State.]

- 1 (2) THE FEES CHARGED SHALL BE SET SO AS TO PRODUCE FUNDS TO
- 2 APPROXIMATE THE COST OF MAINTAINING THE BOARD AS PROVIDED IN

- 17 (II) ANY UNSPENT PORTIONS OF THE BOARD OF VETERINARY
- 18 MEDICAL EXAMINERS FUND MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED OR REVERT TO THE
- 19 GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE, BUT SHALL REMAIN IN THE BOARD OF VETERINARY
- 20 MEDICAL EXAMINERS FUND TO BE USED FOR THE PURPOSES SPECIFIED IN THIS
- 21 TITLE.
- 22 (F) (1) THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OR THE DESIGNEE OF THE
- 23 CHAIRMAN SHALL ADMINISTER THE BOARD OF VETERINARY MEDICAL EXAMINERS
- 24 FUND.
- 25 (2) MONEYS IN THE BOARD OF VETERINARY MEDICAL EXAMINERS FUND
- 26 MAY BE EXPENDED ONLY FOR ANY LAWFUL PURPOSE AUTHORIZED BY THE
- 27 PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE.
- 28 (G) THE LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR SHALL AUDIT THE ACCOUNTS AND
- 29 TRANSACTIONS OF THE BOARD OF VETERINARY MEDICAL EXAMINERS FUND AS
- 30 PROVIDED IN § 2-1220 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
