13 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

14 (1) it is the intent of the General Assembly that, in accordance with §§ 10-209

15 and 10-308.1 of the Natural Resources Article, the Department of Natural Resources

16 utilize special fund revenue generated as a result of the licensing fee increases under

17 this Act, as appropriate, in order to open to public hunting at least half the total

18 acreage that is leased for hunting to private individuals on the properties known as

19 the Chesapeake Forest Lands by the [2005-2006] 2007 2008 2006-2007 hunting

20 season; and

1 (2) the Department shall include in its annual report to the General Assembly 2 a progress report on the public hunting opportunities provided under paragraph (1) of 3 this section.
