- 3 FOR the purpose of eliminating the requirement that a person commissioned by the
- 4 Secretary of Natural Resources to act as a forest or park warden may serve only
- 5 a certain term; and generally relating to the term and duties of a forest or park
- 6 warden.

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 14 Article - Natural Resources

15 5-206.

- 16 (a) The Secretary may commission any person to act as a forest or park
- 17 warden [for a term of two years], subject to removal at any time at the pleasure of
- 18 the Secretary. While holding office, a warden has and may exercise the authority and
- 19 power of a Natural Resources police officer or a law enforcement officer as provided in
- 20 his commission so far as arresting and prosecuting persons for violations of any forest
- 21 or park laws or of the laws, rules and regulations enacted for the protection of the

- 1 State forestry reservations, State parks, historic monuments, recreation areas, or for 2 the protection of fish and game.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 October 1, 2004.
