
- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the fees for certain recreational fishing licenses;

### 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 the date he applies for a license.
- 21 (2) "Resident" includes a member of the armed forces of the United
- 22 States who is on active duty and stationed officially in this State.
- 23 (c) Any person 16 years old or older shall secure an angler's license to fish in
- 24 the nontidal waters of the State. An angler's license entitles the holder to fish in the
- 25 nontidal waters of the State only during the open season.

[The stamp shall be obtained from any authorized agent of the Department at a cost of \$5.] The Department may designate a person engaged in a retail business to sell the trout stamp as an agent under the Department's control and supervision.
