13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 83B - Department of Housing and Community Development

17 (b) (1) The Administration is hereby created as a division of the Department

18 to coordinate the various activities and programs which may contribute to sound

19 community development, to encourage and facilitate the development of new and

20 existing communities by reducing the costs of development through grants, loans, and

21 other forms of financial assistance, to encourage and facilitate energy conservation

22 and the utilization of solar energy in housing and commercial buildings by providing 23 grants, loans, and other forms of financial assistance, making available land for such

24 development and by assisting the efforts of private enterprise, municipalities,

25 counties, local public agencies, local development corporations, and nonprofit

26 organizations.

(2) [Except for grants which may be awarded to the Administration28 under federal law, including without limitation Title V of the Energy Security Act,
