13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

Article 83B - Department of Housing and Community Development

- 17 (b) (1) The Administration is hereby created as a division of the Department
- 18 to coordinate the various activities and programs which may contribute to sound
- 19 community development, to encourage and facilitate the development of new and
- 20 existing communities by reducing the costs of development through grants, loans, and
- 21 other forms of financial assistance, to encourage and facilitate energy conservation

14(II)GRANTS BY THE ADMINISTRATION TO HOME BUYERS FOR15SETTLEMENT EXPENSES.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 17 effect October 1, 2004.
