- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 **Article - State Government**
- 15 10-510.
- If a public body fails to comply with § 10-505, § 10-506, § 10-507, § 16
- 17 10-508, or § 10-509(c) of this subtitle [and a person is affected adversely, the] ANY
- 18 person may file with a circuit court that has venue a petition that asks the court to:
- 19 determine the applicability of those sections; (i)
- require the public body to comply with those sections; or 20 (ii)
- 21 void the action of the public body. (iii)
- 22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 23 October 1, 2004.
