## 2 Commercial Law - Uniform Commercial Code - Repeal of Title 6

- 3 FOR the purpose of repealing Title 6 of the Maryland Uniform Commercial Code
- 4 relating to bulk transfers; making a certain conforming change to Title 2 of the
- 5 Maryland Uniform Commercial Code; providing that the rights and obligations
- 6 that arose under Title 6 of the Maryland Uniform Commercial Code before its
- 7 repeal by this Act remain valid and may be enforced as though Title 6 had not
- 8 been repealed; and generally relating to the repeal of Title 6 of the Maryland
- 9 Uniform Commercial Code.

- 21 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 6-101 through 6-111, inclusive, and the title "Title 6.
- 22 Bulk Transfers" of Article Commercial Law of the Annotated Code of Maryland be
- 23 repealed.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland

- 21 that arose under Title 6 of the Maryland Uniform Commercial Code before its repeal
- 22 by Section 1 of this Act remain valid and may be enforced as though Title 6 had not
- 23 been repealed.
- 24 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 25 October 1, 2004.
