2 Workers' Compensation - Accidental Injury - Unusual Activity

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "accidental personal injury" as it
- 4 pertains to workers' compensation laws, to include an injury that arises out of

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article - Labor and Employment

16 9-101.

- 17 (b) "Accidental personal injury" means:
- 18 (1) an accidental injury that arises:
- 19 (I) out of and in the course of employment; AND
- 20 (II) OUT OF UNUSUAL ACTIVITY;
- 21 (2) an injury caused by a willful or negligent act of a third person
- 22 directed against a covered employee in the course of the employment of the covered
- 23 employee; or
- 24 (3) a disease or infection that naturally results from an accidental injury
- 25 that arises out of and in the course of employment, including:

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- 1 (i) an occupational disease; and
 2 (ii) frostbite or sunstroke caused by a weather condition.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to 4 an accidental injury occurring on or after October 1, 2004.
- 5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2004.
