1 AN ACT concerning

2 Baltimore County Code - 2003 Edition - Legalization

- 3 FOR the purpose of legalizing the 2003 Edition of the Baltimore County Code and any
- 4 supplement to the extent to which that code or supplement contains laws
- 5 enacted by the General Assembly; and generally relating to the 2003 Edition of
- 6 the Baltimore County Code.
- 7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 8 MARYLAND, That the 2003 Edition of the Baltimore County Code and any
- 9 supplement to the 2003 Edition of the Baltimore County Code, to the extent to which
- 10 that code or supplement contains laws enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,
- 11 is legalized. The 2003 Edition of the Baltimore County Code and any supplement
- 12 shall be deemed and taken in all the courts of the State and by all public officials of
- 13 the State and its political subdivisions to be evidence of the law enacted by the
- 14 General Assembly contained in the Code or a supplement to it.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 July 1, 2004.
