BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings** 15 8-210. Any person summoned for jury service may be excused by the 16 17 jury judge if the person shows that undue hardship, extreme inconvenience, or public 18 necessity require his excuse, but only for the period the jury judge deems necessary. 19 At the conclusion of this period the person shall be summoned (II) 20 again for jury service under the provisions of § 8-208 of this [title] SUBTITLE. A MOTHER WHO IS BREAST-FEEDING A CHILD UNDER THE AGE 21 (I) 22 OF 2 YEARS SHALL BE EXCUSED FROM JURY SERVICE BY THE JURY JUDGE. WHEN THE CHILD ATTAINS THE AGE OF 2 YEARS, THE MOTHER 23 (II)24 SHALL BE SUMMONED AGAIN FOR JURY SERVICE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF § 8-208 25 OF THIS SUBTITLE. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 26 27 effect October 1, 2004.
