3	FOR the purpose of declaring a certain plant species to be a noxious weed.
5 6 7 8	BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article - Agriculture Section 9-401 Annotated Code of Maryland (1999 Replacement Volume and 2003 Supplement)
9 10	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
11	Article - Agriculture
12	9-401.
13 14	(a) The existence of growth of certain species of plants is declared to be noxious.
15	(b) The following plants are considered to be noxious weeds in the State:
16 17	(1) Thistles belonging to the asteraceae or compositae family, including Canada, musk, nodding, plumeless, and bull thistle;
18 19	(2) Johnson grass (sorghum halepense) or hybrids that contain Johnson grass as a parent; [and]
20	(3) Shatter cane and wild cane (sorghum bicolor); AND
21 22	(4) MILE-A-MINUTE WEED (ASIATIC TEARTHUMB OR DEVIL'S TEARTHUMB).
23	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
