- 3 FOR the purpose of providing for a certain person to serve as acting Attorney General
- 4 under certain circumstances; establishing the powers and duties of the acting
- 5 Attorney General; setting certain time periods during which the acting Attorney
- 6 General would serve; providing for a certain notice; providing that a certain
- 7 court has exclusive original jurisdiction over certain issues on petition from
- 8 certain persons; authorizing a certain court to pass certain orders; requiring a
- 9 certain proceeding to take precedence and be expedited under certain
- 10 circumstances; and generally relating to procedures for an acting Attorney

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 (A) THE SENIOR DEPUTY ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL SERVE AS ACTING
- 22 ATTORNEY GENERAL IF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TEMPORARILY IS UNABLE OR
- 23 UNAVAILABLE TO CARRY OUT THE DUTIES OF OFFICE.
- 24 (B) IF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL GIVES THE SENIOR DEPUTY ATTORNEY
- 25 GENERAL WRITTEN NOTICE OF A TEMPORARY INABILITY OR UNAVAILABILITY, THE
- 26 ACTING ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL SERVE:
- 27 (1) ON AND AFTER THE DATE THAT THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SETS IN
- 28 THE NOTICE; AND

- 1 UNTIL THE ATTORNEY GENERAL GIVES THE ACTING ATTORNEY (2) 2 GENERAL WRITTEN NOTICE THAT THE ATTORNEY GENERAL IS ABLE TO CARRY OUT 3 THE DUTIES OF OFFICE. IF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL HAS NOT GIVEN NOTICE, BUT THE MEMBERS 5 OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND THE PRESIDING OFFICERS OF THE GENERAL 6 ASSEMBLY MAKE A FORMAL, WRITTEN DETERMINATION OF A TEMPORARY INABILITY 7 OR UNAVAILABILITY OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, THE SENIOR DEPUTY ATTORNEY 8 GENERAL SHALL SERVE AS ACTING ATTORNEY GENERAL: 9 ON AND AFTER THE DATE OF THE DETERMINATION; AND (1) (2) UNTIL THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND THE 11 PRESIDING OFFICERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY JOINTLY DETERMINE AND GIVE 12 THE ATTORNEY GENERAL AND THE ACTING ATTORNEY GENERAL WRITTEN NOTICE 13 THAT THE ATTORNEY GENERAL IS ABLE TO CARRY OUT THE DUTIES OF OFFICE. (D) ON PETITION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS, 14 15 THE PRESIDING OFFICERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE ATTORNEY GENERAL. 16 OR THE ACTING ATTORNEY GENERAL, A CIRCUIT COURT HAS EXCLUSIVE ORIGINAL 17 JURISDICTION TO DETERMINE ANY ISSUE THAT ARISES UNDER THIS SECTION AND 18 TO PASS ANY APPROPRIATE ORDER. EXCEPT FOR CASES THAT THE COURT CONSIDERS OF GREATER 19 20 IMPORTANCE, A PROCEEDING UNDER THIS SECTION, INCLUDING AN APPEAL, SHALL:
- 21 (I) TAKE PRECEDENCE ON THE DOCKET;
- 22 (II) BE HEARD AT THE EARLIEST PRACTICABLE DATE; AND
- 23 (III) BE EXPEDITED IN EVERY WAY.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 25 October 1, 2004.
