18 19	(C) A GIFT CARD OR GIFT CERTIFICATE ISSUED AS A STORE CREDIT MAY NOT CONTAIN AN EXPIRATION DATE OR A SERVICE FEE.
20 21	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a presently existing obligation or contract right may not be impaired in any way by this Act.
24	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any gift certificate or gift card issued before the effective date of this Act.
26 27	SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2004.
