- 7 Board member; establishing an Appeals Board Nominating Committee;
- 8 providing for the membership of the Committee; making a stylistic change;
- 9 requiring the Committee, in the event of a vacancy on the Appeals Board, to
- 10 solicit, interview, and evaluate certain candidates, compile a certain list of
- 11 qualified candidates, and submit the list to the Governor; requiring the
- 12 Governor to nominate a candidate from the list for the vacancy or request that
- 13 the Committee compile and submit another list; providing for reimbursement
- 14 for the expenses of a Committee member; providing for the staff of the
- 15 Committee; making a stylistic change; providing for the application of this Act;
- 16 and generally relating to the State Board of Contract Appeals.
