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A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2                                   **Task Force to Examine and Establish Boundaries of the Prince George's**  
3                                   **County School Board Districts**

4 FOR the purpose of creating a Task Force to Examine and Establish Boundaries of  
5 the Prince George's County School Board Districts; providing for the composition  
6 of the Task Force; requiring the Task Force to choose a chairman from among its  
7 members; requiring Prince George's County to provide staffing for the Task  
8 Force; prohibiting a Task Force member from receiving compensation but  
9 allowing a member to be reimbursed for certain expenses; requiring the Task  
10 Force to examine certain issues and information and establish new boundaries  
11 for Prince George's County School Board districts; requiring the Task Force to  
12 issue a certain report to certain entities on or before a certain date; providing for  
13 the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Task Force to Examine  
14 and Establish Boundaries of the Prince George's County School Board Districts.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
16 MARYLAND, That:

17       (a)       There is a Task Force to Examine and Establish Boundaries of the Prince  
18 George's County School Board Districts.

19       (b)       The Task Force consists of the following members:

20               (1)       2 members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the Chairman of  
21 the Prince George's County Senate Delegation;

22               (2)       2 members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Chairman of  
23 the Prince George's County House Delegation;

24               (3)       2 representatives of the Prince George's County Council, appointed  
25 by the chairman;

26               (4)       2 representatives of the Prince George's County Executive's Office,  
27 appointed by the County Executive; and

1           (5)     3 citizens of Prince George's County, appointed jointly by the  
2 chairmen of the Prince George's County Senate Delegation and the Prince George's  
3 County House Delegation.

4       (c)     The Task Force shall choose a chairman from among its members.

5       (d)     Prince George's County shall provide staff for the Task Force.

6       (e)     A member of the Task Force:

7           (1)     may not receive compensation; but

8           (2)     is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State  
9 Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

10      (f)     The Task Force shall examine the issues and information regarding  
11 current and proposed school board districts in Prince George's County and establish  
12 new boundaries for the Prince George's County school board districts.

13      (g)     The Task Force shall issue a report of its findings and recommendations to  
14 the Prince George's County Senate and House Delegations, the Prince George's  
15 County Council, and the Prince George's County Executive on or before December 1,  
16 2006.

17      SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
18 July 1, 2004. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year, 5 months, and 1 day and,  
19 at the end of December 1, 2006, with no further action required by the General  
20 Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
