## 2 Homicide by Motor Vehicle or Vessel While Fatigued

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the crime of homicide by motor vehicle or vessel
- 4 while fatigued to mean either causing the death of another as a result of driving,
- 5 operating, or controlling a motor vehicle or vessel while knowingly fatigued or
- 6 causing the death of another as a result of falling asleep while driving,

	(A) (1) A PERSON MAY NOT CAUSE THE DEATH OF ANOTHER AS A RESULT OF THE PERSON'S DRIVING, OPERATING, OR CONTROLLING A MOTOR VEHICLE OR VESSEL WHILE KNOWINGLY FATIGUED.
