BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Transportation** 13 14 13-927. 15 (d) The annual registration fee for a Class G (trailer) vehicle is based on the 16 maximum gross weight as follows: 17 For a nonfreight trailer or semitrailer: (1) Maximum Gross Weight Fee 18 19 Limit (in Pounds) 3,000 or less 20 \$ 13.50 3,001 to 5,000 27.00 21 22 5,001 to 10,000 47.25 23 [10,001 to 20,000 81.00]

(2) 25 GROSS WEIGHT LIMIT (IN POUNDS) OF 10,001 TO 20,000 THE FEE IS \$81 AND THE 26 VEHICLE SHALL BE REGISTERED IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING WEIGHT RANGES:
