A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Education - Teachers - Hiring Retirees of the Teachers' Retirement System or the Teachers' Pension System

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a county board of education from hiring certain

- 5 retirees except under certain circumstances; authorizing the hiring of certain
- 6 retirees in certain subject areas, in certain classes for certain students, or in
- 7 certain schools identified by the State Board of Education; authorizing the
- 8 hiring of certain retirees to be teacher mentors; requiring certain county boards
- 9 of education to submit a certain report; requiring the State Department of
- 10 Education to submit a certain report to certain committees; and generally
- 11 relating to the hiring of retirees of the Teachers' Retirement System or the
- 12 Teachers' Pension System.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

21 6-116.

(A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (C) OF THIS SECTION, A
COUNTY BOARD MAY NOT HIRE A RETIREE OF THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM
OR THE TEACHERS' PENSION SYSTEM.

25 (B) A COUNTY BOARD MAY HIRE A RETIREE OF THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT 26 SYSTEM OR THE TEACHERS' PENSION SYSTEM TO TEACH:

27 (1) MATHEMATICS;

1 (2) READING/ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS;

2 (3) SCIENCE;

3 (4) SOCIAL STUDIES;

4 (5) A SPECIAL EDUCATION CLASS FOR STUDENTS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS;

5 (6) A CLASS FOR STUDENTS WITH LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENCY; OR

6 (7) IN A SCHOOL IDENTIFIED BY THE STATE BOARD TO BE UNDER 7 SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT, CORRECTIVE ACTION, OR RESTRUCTURING.

8 (C) A COUNTY BOARD MAY HIRE A RETIREE OF THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT 9 SYSTEM OR THE TEACHERS' PENSION SYSTEM TO BE A PRINCIPAL IN A SCHOOL THAT 10 FAILS TO MEET ADEQUATE YEARLY PROGRESS, AS SET BY THE DEPARTMENT, FOR 2 11 YEARS IN A ROW.

12 (D) A COUNTY BOARD MAY HIRE A RETIREE OF THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT 13 SYSTEM OR THE TEACHERS' PENSION SYSTEM TO BE A TEACHER MENTOR.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That each county board of 15 education shall submit to the State Department of Education by July 1 of each year a 16 report regarding:

17 (1) The number of retirees of the Teachers' Retirement System or the Teachers'18 Pension System that were hired during the previous school year;

19 (2) The subject area or class that the retiree taught; and

20 (3) The school where the retiree taught.

21 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the State Department

22 of Education shall report to the Senate Budget and Taxation and Education, Health,

23 and Environmental Affairs Committees and the House Appropriations and Ways and

24 Means Committees by December 1 of each year, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the

25 State Government Article, regarding the information collected under Section 2 of this26 Act.

27 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 28 effect July 1, 2004.
