#### Security Guards - Certification Renewal - Late Fees

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Secretary of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation the

- 4 <u>State Police</u> to assess a certain late fee to applicants whose application for
- 5 renewal of a security guard certification is not received within a certain time
- 6 period on or before a certain date; prohibiting the Secretary from charging the
- 7 late fee under certain circumstances; capping the amount of total late fees that
- 8 may be assessed against an individual for late certification renewals;
- 9 prohibiting the Secretary from certifying an applicant if the applicant has
- 10 outstanding late fees; and generally relating to the late fees assessed to security
- 11 guards for late certification renewals.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 (a) By regulation, the Secretary shall stagger the terms of the certifications.

1 (b) Unless a certification is renewed for a 3-year term as provided in this 2 section, the certification expires on the date the Secretary sets.

3 (c) At least 90 days before a certification expires, the applicant shall mail to 4 the Secretary:

5	(1)	a renewal application form;
6	(2)	the amount of the renewal fee; and
7	(3)	the amount of any late fee, as determined by the Secretary.
8 (d) An individual periodically may renew the certification for an additional 9 3-year term, if the individual:

SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, IF A COMPLETE 18 (E) (1)19 APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF CERTIFICATION AS REQUIRED UNDER THIS 20 SUBTITLE IS NOT RECEIVED BY THE SECRETARY AT LEAST 30 CALENDAR DAYS 21 BEFORE THE CERTIFICATION EXPIRES ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST BUSINESS DAY OF 22 THE NEXT CALENDAR MONTH IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE RENEWAL DATE, THE 23 SECRETARY SHALL ASSESS A LATE FEE OF \$5 PER DAY UNTIL THE APPLICATION IS 24 RECEIVED BY THE SECRETARY.

25 (2)(I) THE SECRETARY MAY NOT CHARGE A LATE FEE UNDER 26 PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION IF THE APPLICANT DID NOT MAKE TIMELY 27 RENEWAL BECAUSE OF INCAPACITY, HOSPITALIZATION, BEING CALLED TO ACTIVE 28 MILITARY DUTY, OR OTHER HARDSHIP.

THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF LATE FEES ASSESSED AGAINST AN 29 (II) 30 APPLICANT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT EXCEED \$150.

31 THE SECRETARY MAY NOT CERTIFY ANY APPLICANT UNDER THIS (3)32 SUBTITLE IF THE APPLICANT HAS OUTSTANDING LATE FEE OBLIGATIONS.

The Secretary shall renew the certification of each individual 33 [(e)] (F) (1)34 who meets the requirements of this section.

- 1 (2) Within 5 days after the Secretary refuses to renew the certification of 2 an individual as a security guard, the Secretary shall send written notice of the
- 3 refusal to the individual who submitted the renewal application.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 5 October 1, 2004.
