## 2 Public Service Companies - Customer Accounts

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring a public service company to obtain certain identification
- 4 from an individual seeking to open or alter a certain account or an individual
- 5 requesting information about a certain account; prohibiting an individual from
- 6 opening an account with a public service company in another individual's name
- 7 under certain circumstances; providing that a public service company that
- 8 violates a certain provision is liable for certain charges under certain
- 9 circumstances; and generally relating to access to or opening a customer's
- 10 account with a public service company.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 18 Article - Public Utility Companies

19 5-305.

- 20 (A) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT OPEN AN ACCOUNT WITH A PUBLIC SERVICE
- 21 COMPANY WITHOUT FIRST PRODUCING IDENTIFICATION IN THE FORM OF A SOCIAL
- 22 SECURITY NUMBER OR DRIVER'S LICENSE NUMBER.
- 23 (B) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT OPEN AN ACCOUNT WITH A PUBLIC SERVICE
- 24 COMPANY IN ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL'S NAME UNLESS:
- 25 (1) THE INDIVIDUAL HAS OBTAINED AND PRODUCED TO THE PUBLIC
- 26 SERVICE COMPANY WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION FROM THE INDIVIDUAL NAMED ON
- 27 THE ACCOUNT; OR

- 1 (2) THE INDIVIDUAL SEEKING TO OPEN THE ACCOUNT IS ALSO NAMED 2 ON THE ACCOUNT.
- 3 (C) BEFORE AN INDIVIDUAL MAY MAKE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING
- 4 CUSTOMER ACCOUNT WITH A PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OR RECEIVE INFORMATION
- 5 ABOUT AN EXISTING CUSTOMER ACCOUNT, THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY SHALL
- 6 REQUIRE THE INDIVIDUAL TO PRODUCE IDENTIFICATION IN THE FORM OF A
- 7 PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER, SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, DRIVER'S
- 8 LICENSE NUMBER, OR PASSWORD.
- 9 (D) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER REMEDIES PROVIDED BY LAW, IF A PUBLIC
- 10 SERVICE COMPANY FAILS TO OBTAIN IDENTIFICATION FROM AN INDIVIDUAL IN
- 11 VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION, THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY SHALL BE
- 12 RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY CHARGES TO AN ACCOUNT THAT ARE INCURRED AS A
- 13 RESULT OF THE CREATION OF AN UNAUTHORIZED ACCOUNT OR OF AN
- 14 UNAUTHORIZED CHANGE.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 October 1, 2004.
