

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

- 31 (c) The failure or refusal of a certified nursing assistant OR CERTIFIED
- 32 MEDICATION TECHNICIAN to submit to an examination required under subsection (b)
- 33 of this section is prima facie evidence of the inability of the certified nursing assistant
- 34 OR CERTIFIED MEDICATION TECHNICIAN to competently practice as a certified
- 35 nursing assistant OR CERTIFIED MEDICATION TECHNICIAN, unless the Board finds

- 1 that the failure or refusal was beyond the control of the certified nursing assistant OR
- 2 CERTIFIED MEDICATION TECHNICIAN.
- 3 (d) The Board shall pay the cost of any examination made in accordance with
- 4 the provisions of this section.
