## 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That, notwithstanding any other provision of law, for fiscal years 2002

through [2005] 2007, in each year, the State shall provide 90 percent of the eligible 17

18 costs for up to and including \$20 million in public school construction projects in

19 Baltimore City, and for funding above \$20 million, the State shall provide 75 percent 20 of the eligible costs.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 22 June 1, 2004.
