15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That, notwithstanding any other provision of law, for fiscal years 2002

17 through [2005] 2007, in each year, the State shall provide 90 percent of the eligible

18 costs for up to and including \$20 million in public school construction projects in

19 Baltimore City, and for funding above \$20 million, the State shall provide 75 percent

20 of the eligible costs.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 June 1, 2004. SENATE BILL 413
