10 FOR the purpose of clarifying that a person without lawful authority may not
interfere with the operation of a traffic control device or a railroad sign or signal;
prohibiting a person without lawful authority from possessing, with an intent to
use, certain devices capable of transmitting certain signals for the purpose of
altering or interfering with the operation of a traffic control device or a railroad
sign or signal; providing for a certain penalty; and generally relating to

- 18 control device or any railroad sign or signal, including any inscription, shield, or

- 20 (e) A person without lawful authority may not willfully injure any traffic
- 21 control device or any railroad sign or signal, including any inscription, shield, or
- 22 insignia on it.
- 23 (d) A person without lawful authority may not willfully knock down any traffic
- 24 control device or any railroad sign or signal, including any inscription, shield, or
- 25 insignia on it.
