BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 15 **Article - Education** 16 5-202. 17 SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, EACH YEAR THE (I) (1) 18 STATE SHALL DISTRIBUTE A STATE SUPPLEMENT TO FEDERAL IMPACT AID TO A 19 COUNTY BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBSECTION. THE STATE SUPPLEMENT TO FEDERAL IMPACT AID IS EQUAL TO THE 20 21 DIFFERENCE, IF ANY, BETWEEN: 22 THE BASIC SUPPORT PAYMENT DUE TO THE COUNTY BOARD AS (I)23 PROVIDED IN 20 U.S.C. § 7703 USING STUDENT DATA FROM THE MOST RECENT YEAR 24 FOR WHICH DATA IS AVAILABLE; AND

26 THE COUNTY BOARD IN THE MOST RECENT YEAR FOR WHICH DATA IS AVAILABLE.
