7 Board to continue serving as a member of the Board until a successor is

8 appointed and qualifies; providing that certain terms do not count toward the

9 term limit; providing for staggered terms for certain members of the Board; and

10 generally relating to the terms of the members of the Board of Trustees of

11 Chesapeake College.

### 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

21 (a) (1) The Board of Trustees of Chesapeake College consists of two

22 members from each county that supports Chesapeake College who shall be appointed

23 by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the [House of Delegates] SENATE.

24 (2) The county superintendents of schools in the region are not ex officio 25 members.

26 (b) (1) (I) Each member serves for a term of [4] 5 years.

27 (II) THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED
 28 BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD ON JULY 1, 2004.

## 1 (III) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE 2 UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

3 (2) (i) Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, a member 4 appointed to begin a FULL term on or after July 1, [2000] 2004, may not serve for 5 more than three [4-year] 5-YEAR terms.

6 (ii) A term of a member that began before July 1, [2000] 2004, does 7 not count toward the term limit established in subparagraph (i) of this paragraph.

8 (c) Each member of the Board:

9 (1) Serves without compensation; and

10 (2) Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses in accordance with 11 applicable travel regulations.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of office for the 13 following incumbent members of the Board of Trustees of Chesapeake College shall 14 expire as follows:

15 (1) the members representing Caroline and Dorchester counties whose 16 terms are due to expire in 2004 shall expire on June 30, 2005;

17 (2) the member representing Kent County whose term is due to expire in 18 2004 shall expire on June 30, 2006;

19(3)the members representing Dorchester and Queen Anne's counties20whose terms are due to expire in 2006 shall expire on June 30, 2007; and

21 (4) the members representing Caroline and Kent counties whose terms
22 are due to expire in 2006 shall expire on June 30, 2008.

23 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 July 1, 2004.
