1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Queen Anne's County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class A Light Wine License**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a Class A light wine license to be issued in Queen  
4 Anne's County; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Queen  
5 Anne's County.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
7 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
8 Section 4-201(a)  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (2001 Replacement Volume and 2003 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

14 4-201.

15 (a) A Class A light wine license may be issued only in:

- 16 (1) Baltimore County;
- 17 (2) Carroll County;
- 18 (3) Dorchester County;
- 19 (4) Frederick County;

- 1           (5)     Garrett County;
- 2           (6)     Harford County;
- 3           (7)     Montgomery County;
- 4           (8)     QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY;
- 5           [(8)]   (9)     Somerset County;
- 6           [(9)]   (10)    Talbot County; and
- 7           [(10)]  (11)    Washington County.

8           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
9 June 1, 2004.
