19 20	(B) (1) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A WINE TASTING (WT) ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE.	

- 1 (2) A WT LICENSE AUTHORIZES, FOR TASTING OR SAMPLING ONLY, THE 2 ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION OF WINE THAT CONTAINS NOT MORE THAN  $\frac{14\%}{22\%}$  OF 3 ALCOHOL BY VOLUME.
- 4 (3) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, THE LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED 5 TO A HOLDER OF A CLASS A BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE OR A CLASS A BEER 6 AND WINE LICENSE.
- 7 (4) THE LICENSEE MAY NOT SERVE:
- 8 <u>(I) NOT MORE THAN <del>1 OUNCE</del> 2 OUNCES</u> FROM EACH GIVEN 9 BRAND TO ANY ONE PERSON; AND
- 10 (II) NOT MORE THAN 4 OUNCES TO ANY ONE PERSON IN A SINGLE 11 DAY.
- 12 (5) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE FOR A WT LICENSE IS \$100 IN ADDITION 13 TO THE FEE FOR ANY OTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE.
- 14 (C) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO 15 CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 17 June 1, 2004.
