A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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(D) BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2006, ANY SUBSIDY RECEIVED BY THE STATE
 THAT IS PROVIDED TO EMPLOYERS AS A RESULT OF THE FEDERAL MEDICARE
 PRESCRIPTION DRUG, IMPROVEMENT, AND MODERNIZATION ACT OF 2003, SHALL BE
 DEPOSITED INTO THE ACCUMULATION FUND OF THE POSTRETIREMENT HEALTH
 FUNDING SYSTEM.

6 (E) THE ASSETS OF THE POSTRETIREMENT HEALTH FUNDING SYSTEM SHALL
7 BE INVESTED IN THE SAME MANNER AS THOSE OF THE OTHER SYSTEMS OF THE
8 STATE RETIREMENT AND PENSION SYSTEM.

9 (F) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006 THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 2016, NO PAYMENTS MAY 10 BE MADE FROM THE ACCUMULATION FUND OF THE POSTRETIREMENT HEALTH 11 FUNDING SYSTEM.

12 (G) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE STATE
13 RETIREMENT AND PENSION SYSTEM SHALL TRANSFER TO THE GENERAL FUND, FOR
14 THE SOLE PURPOSE OF ASSISTING IN THE PAYMENT OF THE STATE'S
15 POSTRETIREMENT HEALTH INSURANCE SUBSIDY, THE LESSER OF:

16 (1) ONE-QUARTER OF THE PRIOR YEAR'S INVESTMENT GAINS OF THE 17 POSTRETIREMENT HEALTH FUNDING SYSTEM; OR

(2) THE AMOUNT NECESSARY TO PAY THE ANNUAL HEALTH INSURANCE
 PREMIUMS AND OTHER COSTS THAT CONSTITUTE THE STATE'S POSTRETIREMENT
 HEALTH INSURANCE SUBSIDY SPECIFIED IN § 2-508 OF THIS ARTICLE.

21 (H) IF FOR ANY REASON THE STATE DISCONTINUES THE POSTRETIREMENT
22 HEALTH INSURANCE SUBSIDY SPECIFIED IN § 2-508 OF THIS ARTICLE OR A
23 SUCCESSOR SUBSIDY, THE ASSETS OF THE POSTRETIREMENT HEALTH FUNDING
24 SYSTEM SHALL BE TRANSFERRED TO THE GENERAL FUND.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 July 1, 2004.
