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## CHAPTER

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1 AN ACT concerning

## Coastal Bays Fishing Guide License Permit - Establishment

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a person who provides certain fishing guide services in 4 certain locations to obtain a certain Coastal Bays fishing guide license permit; 5 requiring the Department of Natural Resources to issue a certain Coastal Bays 6 fishing guide license permit beginning on a certain date; prohibiting a certain 7 recreational angler from possessing a certain species of fish; establishing certain requirements for the issuance and renewal of a tieense permit; requiring that license permit fees be credited to certain funds a certain fund; requiring the Department to report certain information publicly at a certain time; requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations; making certain technical corrections and stylistic changes; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to a certain Coastal Bays fishing guide license permit.

33 (C) THE COASTAL BAYS FISHING GUIDE LICENSE PERMIT IS VALID IN THE 34 FOLLOWING TIDAL WATERS OF THE ATLANTIC COASTAL BAYS WATERSHED:

10 VESSEL WITHOUT COMPLIANCE WITH APPROPRIATE FEDERAL REGULATIONS
11 GOVERNING THE OPERATION OF A VESSEL CARRYING PASSENGERS FOR HIRE;

12 (II) 1. LIMIT TO $30 \underline{25}$ THE NUMBER OF COASTAL BAYS FISHING
13 GUIDE LICENSES PERMITS ISSUED ANNUALLY; AND
14 2. ALLOCATE NOT MORE THAN 20\% OF THOSE LICENSES 15 PERMITS TO NONRESIDENTS; AND

16 (III) ESTABLISH A WAITING LIST FOR APPLICANTS IN EXCESS OF
17 THE NUMBER OF COASTAL BAYS FISHING GUIDE LICENSES PERMITS AVAILABLE
18 EACH YEAR, INCLUDING CRITERIA FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE WAITING LIST.
19 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 June 1, 2004. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and 3 months and, at the
21 end of August 31, 2007, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this
22 Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
