- 21 (a) Unless there is a special danger that requires a lower speed to comply with
- 22 § 21-801 of this subtitle, the limits specified in this section or otherwise established
- 23 under this subtitle are maximum lawful speeds. A person may not drive a vehicle on
- 24 a highway at a speed that exceeds these limits.
